3 Pillars Learning- Students are active participants in defining ambitious learning goals and engaging in their progress. • Backpack League	Stone	10 minutes	
Eva shared that the JCPS Backpack League will be held June 15th- 26th and July 6th-17th 2020. Classes will be taught by pairs of teachers, this is a project-based learning initiative with an objective to maintain or improve reading and math outcomes in students grades 3-6th She also shared work being done by JCPS APRNs as well as Doctors for Healthy Communities (DHC). To date data has been reported on 5 school clinics for a total of: 601 physicals and 56 dental screenings with the following referrals: 230 vision, 49 mental health, 68 dental, 128 health conditions, 13 food insecurity. Talked about the necessity of this work for children lacking access to health care as a means to ensure kids are in class and ready to learn.

Andrea reported on the Nutrition and Physical Activity report presentation to the school board in December and a public forum will be held on January 23rd from 4:00-6:00 PM in Stuart auditorium in the VanHoose building. Craig Hammons updated the committee on the school support visits and implementation in JCPS. Andrea discussed a Healthy Schools Toolbox she has developed as a guide for school staff for implementation.

Eva presented a brief update on the work JCPS is involved in to reduce & prevent e-cigarette use in students.

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Eva reported for MeMe- talked about the Google site that MeMe has developed for health and PE teachers as well as additional district staff involved in health. She has started a monthly Professional Learning Community for health/PE teachers that meets face-to-face or virtually. Work is also underway to plan a Summer PD institute for school staff on WSCC related components.

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Andrea Wright: Shared that nutrition services will have a food truck. Western Culinary students are involved and she is working with them on prep of food truck. The truck will go to HS campuses 1st. Lots of details to be worked out- stay tuned!

Michelle Sircy- Suicide prevention update- they have added new components and expanded to include training with 4th and 5th- curriculum is a 4-part lesson done in a small class setting. 4th grade lesson- didn't talk suicide but rather positive coping skills.

Middle/high- done at the start of school as required by law. Now JCPS is doing a mid-year booster (warning signs, TED talk by teen, student to student). Also 12 additional schools have been trained in the sources of strength.

Catherine Graber: Update on Compassionate Schools- PD on Feb 1st: Care for teachers. ½ day training- tools and resources to decrease stress. Feb 3rd: Author talk about new book called the Mindful School (Dr. Tish Jennings- Mindfulness for teachers)



Nikki Boyd: Works with Pre K through HS and families

Teen Wellness Workshop: coming up at Atherton Open airways- 3rd - 5th grade: asthma management

Her team at Norton is also working on their own version of vaping education

Angela Hayes- Shared that JCPS has submitted an application to the state to participate in the Vaccines for Children program

Rina Gratz/LaTonya Blount- Shared that they appreciate the work with Shawnee Christian Care. They have been a tremendous help to preschool families, especially dental

Leesa Mattingly (Norton Cancer Institute): She is happy to come into schools and discuss breast health, breast exams; sun safety, HPV, smoking cessation.

She shares that Norton does a career ladder with nurses and there is an opportunity to get volunteer nurses for school health (ex for immunization clinics) as they need hours to advance on the career ladder.
