Minutes from previous meeting	A majority of the committee members present approved the minutes from the September 3, 2019 meeting.
Review of Previous Meeting	<p>Dr. Pollio presented a recap of the previous meetings, noting that there are several ideas that have been previously floated by committees looking at magnet school systems, including Magnet Schools of America and the Magnet Steering committee.</p> <p>Dr. Pollio shared that the Advisory Committee will continue to review some of those proposals as well as those generated by the group to determine which make the most sense to continue forward.</p>
Equity and Access	<p>Three areas were explored during the meeting: central office management of magnet admissions processes, diversity targets and goals, and magnet exits. Cassie Blausey and Barbara Dempsey facilitated the discussion of those ideas around three guiding questions: (1) What is the positive impact of the recommendation; (2) What could be the unintended consequences of the recommendation; and (3) What are some important considerations to take into account if the recommendation is to move forward?</p> <p>The committee generally agreed to move the ideas forward. No vote was taken.</p>
Next Meeting	The following dates were scheduled as future Advisory Committee meetings: October 10, October 22, November 7, November 19, and December 3, 2019.
