I. Call Community Forum to Order

II. Greetings from Chairwoman Diane Porter and Superintendent Marty Pollio

David Schlar discussed Exceptional Child Education and explained the obstacles that his son has faced with developmental delay and his need for Extended School Year Services. He expressed frustration with the IEP process and talked about the need to improve the way an IEP is developed.
