Highlight of Legislations & Regulations Impacting SPP & ALGF	Jonathan Lowe	Jonathan Lowe is keeping up with changes in Frankfort as they occur. He has added/edited language in the Handbook drafts as needed to comply and align with state and district policies and regulations.
SPP Reports from Subcommittees	Subcommittee Leads	Elementary SPP Middle SPP High SPP HS - Danielle Washburn discussed items that they want to ensure are clear in the SPP, such as Algebra II references and Dual credit. The Seal of Arts was also discussed. This is a new seal that can go on the diploma very similar to the BiLiteracy Seal we have. This is a state initiative lead by Arts Lead, Melisa Gano (Suggestion: Add under part D -High School Diplomas 1) Advanced Program 2)BiLiteracy 3) Arts Excellence on the SPP). Dual Credit courses taken online, through a Facilitator, or on a college campus will not have progress grades since they are not taught by a JCPS teacher. (Add under part B on the SPP and add to the ALGF) MS - Jennifer Cave mentioned updating the SPP to reflect board policies or regulation changes, which Jonathan will address. She added that training for schools and messaging to families are important considerations as we move forward with the current Handbooks as well as future implementation of SBG. In the future, MS will be recommending a change to increase the length of the grading terms. ES - Maddie Shepard shared their suggested changes concerning incompletes, clarification of retention, and posting grades. It was also suggested that the intent of the JCBE Homework Policy be bolded in the Handbooks.

ALGF Reports from Subcommittees	Subcommittee Leads	ALGF Links HS - Karen Cash explained that the HS Subcommittee needed to spend more time reviewing the ALGF with the lens used by MS and ES, and will do so by the next meeting. MS - Jennifer Cave shared that their subcommittee is looking at different options under "assignments" within the categories and discussed the language around feedback. ES - Maddie Shepard discussed long-term planning to move forward, asking that sub-chairs meet and stay on the same page. She also discussed the need for clarifying language.
		Alan Young shared a concern around the language and suggested timelines around incompletes, noting that it is different at different levels and asking if the ES subcommittee will look at incompletes for the final grading period to possibly have a timeline rather than not being allowed. He also suggested that reasoning be included in the language to explain the differences among levels. In the current Handbooks, incompletes are not included at all in the Elementary policy, so the ES is recommending they be added, with language indicating they will not be allowed in the final grading period. A couple of action items were suggested to keep schools on track: 1) adding "Clean-up Incompletes" to the Principal Time Task Calendar, and 2) adding "Post Grades to the Transcript" to the Principal Time Task Calendar.
